## **Invitation to Apply for Eligibility and to Bid**


### **Supply, Delivery and Installation of Various Equipment and Peripherals for the Upgrading and Enhancement of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) System installed at the NAPOLCOM Building**

1. The *NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION*, through the continuing appropriations intends to apply the sum of *Six Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand One Hundred Sixty Pesos (PhP629,160.00)* being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Various Equipment and peripherals for the upgrading and enhancement of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) System installed at the NAPOLCOM Building. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.
2. The *NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION* now invites Bids from eligible Bidders for *the Supply and Delivery of abovementioned Equipment*. Delivery of the GOODS is required by November 2009. The description of an eligible Bidder is contained in Section II of the Bidding Documents, ITB.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A (IRR-A) of Republic Act 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act," and is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to Republic Act 5183 (R.A. 5183) and subject to Commonwealth Act 138 (C.A. 138). Only Bids from Bidders who pass the eligibility check will be opened. The process for the eligibility check is described in Section II of the Bidding Documents, ITB. The bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall advance to the post-qualification stage in order to finally determine responsiveness of the bid to technical and financial requirements of the project. The contract shall then be awarded to the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) who was determined as such during the post-qualification procedure.
