**ADOPTING THE EDUCATION AND AGE REQUIREMENTS  
FOR THE PNP ENTRANCE EXAMINATION**

**WHEREAS**, current NAPOLCOM policy prohibits the appointment to the Philippine National Police of applicants who have not finished a four-year college course or who are below twenty years of age;

**WHEREAS**, the law itself does not prohibit the aforesaid undergraduates and underaged applicants from taking the police entrance examination;

**WHEREAS**, said NAPOLCOM policy can be amended by a corresponding new policy allowing those who are undergraduates or below twenty (20) years of age to take the police examinations.

**WHEREAS**, this is in line with Section 32 of RA No. 6975, as amended by Section 21 of RA No. 8551, to wit:


*"The National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examinations for policemen on the basis of the standards set by the Commission."*

**WHEREAS**, these proposed amendments will enlarge the base from which future policemen can be drawn;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO ADOPT, AS IT HEREBY ADOPTS**, the following education and age requirements for the PNP entrance examination:

1. Applicants with at least seventy-two (72) college units are qualified to take the PNP entrance examination
2. Applicants for the PNP entrance examination should be at least eighteen (18) years old

**ADOPTED** this 24th day of FEBRUARY in the Year Two Thousand and Six, in Makati City, Metro Manila, Philippines.
