RESOLUTION NO. 2006-075

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO 2000-173 DATED NOVEMBER 16, 2000 APPROVING A FIXED LEVEL OF PASSING FOR PNP SUPERINTENDENT AND INSPECTOR EXAMINATIONS ADMINISTERED BY THE COMMISSION AND RAISING THE CUT-OFF SCORES THEREOF.

**WHEREAS**, Section 21 of Republic Act 8551, otherwise known as the PNP Reform and Reorganization Act of 1998 and which amended Section 32 of Republic Act 6975, the PNP Law of 1990, provides that the National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examination for policemen on the basis of the standards set by the Commission;

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with the mandate of this Act, the Commission conducts twice a year the PNP Entrance and Promotional Examinations;

**WHEREAS**, in congruence with our migration to the Optic Scanner Based Program using the criterion-reference testing vis-à-vis checking of examinations, it is necessary that a fixed level of passing be provided for each examination category in order to facilitate the early release of examination results and expedite the enabling of examinees to possess the appropriate police service eligibility for appointment or promotion in the service;


**WHEREAS**, the Napolcom Test Development Committee sees the need to raise the cut-off scores of all the examination categories in order to help the Philippine National Police recruit the best and promote officers through the merit and fitness system.

**WHEREAS**, the Commission finds the recommendation of the Napolcom Test Development Committee meritorious and in harmony with the provisions of related laws;


**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP under Section 6 of Article XVI of the Constitution, in relation to Section 14 of R.A. 6975 as amended by Section 5 of R.A. 8551 has resolved to approve as it hereby approves the following cut-off scores for the examinations conducted on October 23, 2005 and thereafter.

<u>Examination title</u>	<u>Recommended cut-off scores</u>
POLICE SUPERINTENDENT	-55% of the total scores equivalent to 110 correct answers out of 200 test items
POLICE INSPECTOR	-55% of the total scores equivalent to 110 correct answers out of 200 test items
